



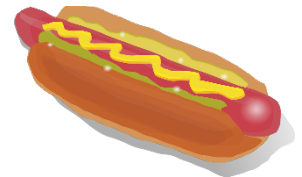
You Are Invited to the Michigan Brittany Club Annual Picnic!

Food

Hot dogs, hamburgers, pop and water provided by the Club. Please bring a dish to pass and water for your dogs. The picnic is a good opportunity to see and participate in field events if you are not familiar with them already and/or to invite prospective members and new Brittany owners to introduce them to club activities.

Field Trial Events Information

Field events will take place starting at 8:00 a.m., so please come early. Each stake will begin upon the completion of the stake before it, so starting times for each stake will depend upon the number of dogs entered in the prior stakes. Field events (in order) and cost per dog are:

Gun Dog (Trophy) – open to all dogs *of Club Members*, cost is \$7/dog (Your dog must be steady to both wing and shot and not be a finished Field Champion or have won this event previously.)

Hunting Dog – open to all dogs 6 months of age and over, cost is \$7/dog (Steady to wing)

Hunting Dog Veterans – open to all dogs 8 years of age and over, cost is \$7/dog (Steady to wing)

Derby – open to all dogs 6 months to 2 years of age, cost is \$5/dog (Must point a bird)

Puppy – open to all dogs 6 to 15 months of age, cost \$5/dog (Judged on potential, do not have to find a bird)

Please have all entries for the **Gun Dog** event in by Saturday, August 10, 2019 at the latest. Entries for all of the other events can be taken up to and including the day of the picnic. Fees for all events are payable on the day of the picnic prior to running your dog. Please email Kim McVeigh at jazzbuster@earthlink.net or call her at 248-345-4142 (mobile) to enter any of the events. Blank guns will be fired in all stakes (with discretion for puppies). NO LIVE AMMUNITION. We will draw the names out of a hat to determine the order. The trophy/gun dog stake dates back to 1949. It contains the engraved names of some of the finest dogs our club has produced over the years. Winner will get to take the trophy home for a year.
